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Course Overview

Foreign Information Manipulation and Interference (FIMI) is the contemporary term used to describe coordinated disinformation, propaganda, and influence operations conducted by state and state-aligned actors. These activities target democratic processes, critical infrastructure, public trust, and organisational decision-making.

This intensive FIMI Responder Course equips participants with the skills, frameworks, and operational understanding required to identify, assess, respond to, and counter FIMI activity. - Measuring influence, assessing harm, and identifying strategic intent
- Response and Mitigation Strategies
- Disruption, attribution, counter-messaging, and resilience-based approaches
- Legal, Ethical, and Policy Considerations
- Freedom of expression, governance, and proportional response
- Case Studies and Practical Exercises
- Real-world FIMI incidents with hands-on analysis and response planning
