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Course Overview

Managing digital investigation teams requires more than traditional supervisory skills. Many managers and supervisors find themselves responsible for internet investigation staff, cyber investigators, and digital intelligence teams without having previously worked directly within the digital investigation environment themselves.

The Managing Digital Investigation Teams Course is a practical 2-day intensive programme designed specifically for Government managers and supervisors who oversee staff conducting internet-based investigations and intelligence activity.

The course provides leaders with a broad understanding of the tools, techniques, legal frameworks, operational considerations, and supervisory responsibilities associated with digital investigations. It enables managers to better understand what their teams are doing, identify underutilised opportunities, ensure compliance with legislation and authorisation requirements, and provide effective operational oversight.

This course is focused on helping leaders confidently manage digital investigators while maintaining legal compliance, evidential integrity, staff welfare, and operational effectiveness.

Who is the course for?

This course is designed for Government professionals with responsibility for supervising or managing digital investigation staff, including:

- Investigative team supervisors and managers
- Intelligence unit leaders
- Senior investigators overseeing internet-based enquiries
- Operational managers responsible for cyber and digital teams
- Department heads managing digital intelligence capability
- Staff transitioning into supervisory roles within digital investigations

No technical investigative experience is required—this course is specifically designed for leaders and decision-makers.





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Course Content

The course provides strategic and operational understanding across key supervisory areas, including:

- Introduction to Digital Investigation Management
- Understanding the role of the digital investigator and the manager's responsibilities
- Digital Investigation Capabilities and Opportunities
- OSINT, internet investigations, covert online activity, platform exploitation, and evidential recovery
- Legal Authorities and Legislative Frameworks
- Relevant Government legislation, authorisation thresholds, proportionality, necessity, and oversight
- Covert Activity and Governance
- Supervisory considerations around covert online identities, sensitive investigations, and operational approvals
- Evidence Recovery and Evidential Standards
- Managing product recovery, validation, disclosure, and evidential integrity
- Operational Security and Technical Risk
- Protecting investigations, managing exposure, and safeguarding organisational capability
- Managing the Digital Operative
- Staff welfare, resilience, exposure to harmful content, burnout, and professional development
- Capability Development and Resource Management
- Identifying training needs, capability gaps, and future operational opportunities
- Case Studies and Practical Discussions
- Real-world supervisory challenges and lessons learned from operational environments

- Identify where investigative capability may be underused or underdeveloped within teams

- Recognise thresholds for authorisations and covert activity requirements
- Support evidential integrity and professional investigative standards
- Manage operational risk, technical security, and investigator welfare
- Supervise digital investigators effectively while maintaining accountability and compliance
- Make informed decisions regarding resourcing, prioritisation, and operational direction
